# Ashbourne Campus Milang Campus

#### **Facilities**

- Campus building and facilities although the APAs (Asset Performance Assessments) were lodged by DPTI with DfE Asset Services in mid October we are yet to have any response. This is frustrating when you consider the deteriorating state of our facilities. 2020 will see students once again placed in facilities where stationery rolls off desks, the floors are so uneven that the desks won't sit evenly, windows don't open and don't seal properly, exterior timber is rotting and to the point that sections regularly fall off if they are touched and first aid is provided over the staffroom kitchen sink with no separate hand washing facilities
