Any member appointed outside of the general election cycle must have their position opened at the next election, as per the constitution. This applies to 4 current positions being 1, 8, 9, 10 above.

What this means is that in February 2020 GC will need to call for eight (8) nominations. Five of those positions will be for a **2 year** term, and 3 of those positions will be for a **1 year term**, to bring the cycle back to having only five (5) positions vacant each year as per the Constitution.

Melanie Priestly and Melanie McAnaney are the only 2 current GC members not required to re-nominate in 2020.
