

SCHOOL SUPPLIED LAPTOP PROGRAM

Year 7 2026



The School Supplied Laptop Program operates so that all Year 7 students can equitably engage in positive learning opportunities that will improve outcomes and develop skills that will be beneficial to them throughout their lives



Laptops are purchased by the school and are available for families of Year 7 students to purchase over 3 years. Families will pay 3 yearly installments of \$400 (total \$1200).

School card holders receive the device free of charge.

Laptops remain the property of the school until the end of the 3 year signed agreement and all fees have been paid in full.



What does the cost include?

- Laptop and protective case
- Access to the schools wireless network and filtered high speed internet
- A suite of school licensed software and all upgrades
- Technical Support from school based ICT staff / onsite repair and hot swap device
- 3 year on-site warranty and battery warranty
- Accidental Damage Protection which includes unlimited repairs, with no extra costs and 1 full replacement unit during 3 year term of warranty
