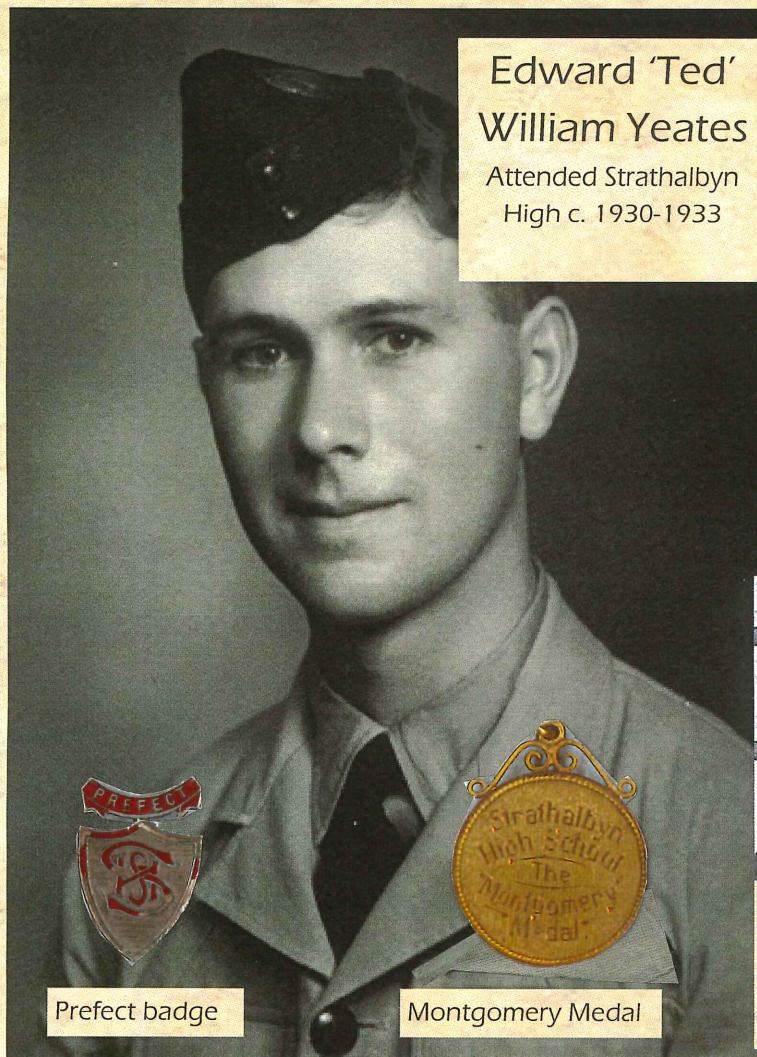

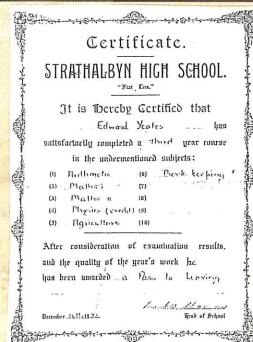
Stirling House

1933 Stirling House Leader & Prefect. He also won the very prestigious Montgomery Medal which is awarded to the top boy for all-round excellence and leadership.

Named after George W Montgomery, Chairman of the High School 1917-34. Ted's brother Rupert won a similar award in 1926 and 1927 when it was called the Stirling Medal, awarded by Sir JL Stirling. Rupert was also Head Prefect in 1927, football best and fairest 1928 and Mail Medal 1934.
